The Duke of Edinburgh's Award is a programme of personal development. It is designed to test a candidates' commitment, persistence and initiative. The Silver Award is open to pupils in Form IV and above who have completed their Bronze Award (or are new pupils to the school)

The Silver Award

To gain the Silver Award you will need to undertake activities in each of the four sections shown in the table below and demonstrate improvement through persistence and commitment. There should be regular commitment over the time period shown below averaging at least an hour a week for each section. Completion of all four sections of the Award will result in the presentation of a Silver DofE badge and certificate.

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award at Dollar Academy

Dollar Academy has a wealth of co-curricular activities and opportunities that can help a pupil fulfil the requirements of their DofE programme. Activities and opportunities that take place out of school can also be used. DofE candidates are responsible for setting up and organising their own placements in the Volunteering, Skill and Physical Recreation sections. The Academy will organise and set up the Expedition section for 77 candidates who wish to use walking as their chosen mode of transport. Expedition training will take place this session in early June somewhere in the Highlands, followed by expedition assessment in N.W. Scotland later in June. The cost for registering for the Award, both expeditions, tent/stove hire, plus a refundable £30 hire deposit is £276.50.
